We have prepared Student survey forms with certain questionnaire by considering the following factors

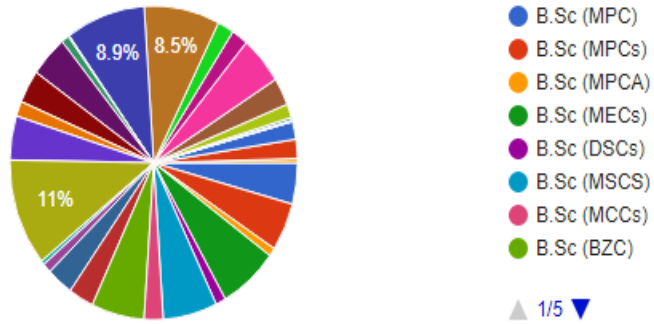
