**Academic Year: 2017-18 : SEMESTER I**

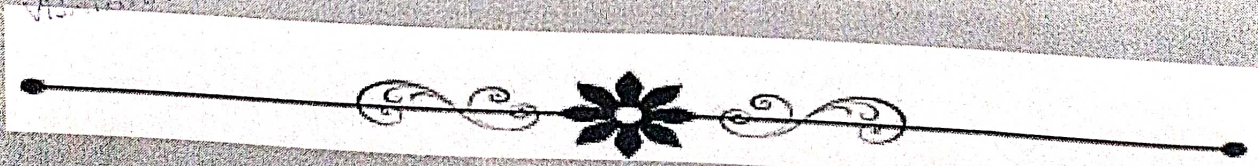
**No. Of Feedback forms collected from different stakeholders= 49**
