1st B.A. Journalism has two semesters i.e.,

Semester -II, titled - Principles of Communication

2nd B.A. Journalism has two semesters i.e.,

Semester -III, titled - Journalism Writing Skills

Semester - IV, titled - Reporting and Editinng

Resolutions:

- Resolved to adopt the syllabus for semester III and IV (II Year) with the suggested modifications. And reapproved the syllabus of I and II semester(I year) for the academic year 2018-19
- 2. Resolved to approve the division of marks for internal and external examination along with the suggested blue print and model paper.
- In each Semester 100 marks paper is divided into two parts.
 - 60 marks caters to External evaluation and
 - 40 marks caters to Internal assessment
- 4. 60 marks in External assessment is divided as

 - 5 marks for Viva/ Assessment

 - 10 marks for Project work
 - 10 marks for the Best of the two mid examinations
