

The chairman, Board of Studies welcomed the members in Google meet Platform and initiated the discussion of the syllabus for semesters I, II, III and V. He appraised the members of Board of Studies and the guidelines of the UGC, APSCHE, and the CCE regarding the framing of syllabus and the recommended Evaluation ratio for Internal and External examinations. The members discussed in detail the various aspects presented before them and unanimously resolved the following.

Resolutions :

- 1. The committee has resolved and approved the present CBCS syllabus revamped for semester III & V.
- 2. The committee resolved and approved the revised CBCS syllabus for semester I and II on the recommendations of APSCHE (Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education)
- 3. The committee resolved and approved the division of marks for Internal and External Examinations i.e., 40 for Internal and 60 marks for External Examination.
- 4. The committee has resolved and approved the Blueprint and the Model Question Paper has to be designed in such a way that 24 marks to be obtained from each Unit/ Module.
- 5. The committee resolved to approve the division of Internal Marks i.e.,
 - a) 10 marks for Internal Exam (Best of the Two)
 - b) 10 marks for Assignments (Two Assignments)
 - c) 10 marks for Project work
 - d) 5 marks for Attendance
 - e) 5 marks for Student seminar
- 6. The committee resolved to enhance the theory examination time duration from Two and Half hours to Three Hours duration as the majority of the students requested.
- 7. The committee resolved to conduct the External Examination either in Offline or Online or Blended in the view of COVID Pandemic Situation.

- 8. The committee resolved the list of Paper setters and External Examiners submitted by the department.
- 9. The committee has approved the syllabus for Bridge Course in UG Journalism for new entrants in I B.A. Journalism students in Semester I. It should be with 15 teaching hours and to conduct Internal Examination for evaluation designed by respective department.
