Report:

Department of Botany , SRR & CVR Govt Degree College faculty and students participated in Three day Workshop organized by TECH 2018, UNESCO, MGIEP, Visakhapatnam .

Transforming Education Conference for Humanity (TECH) 2018, the second edition of UNESCO Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Education for Peace and Sustainable Development (MGIEP)'s international conference in association with the State Government of Andhra Pradesh concluded by drawing a blueprint for harnessing pedagogical possibilities opened up by digital technologies.

The Aim of the three-day conference was to showcase the role of games and digital learning in enabling a shift from “transmissive pedagogies” to “transformative pedagogies” to create peaceful and sustainable societies. Nearly 1,500 people from over 50 countries participated in the TECH 2018 Conference .

The most significant outcome of the conference was the Vizag Declaration on Guidelines for Digital Learning, adopted against the backdrop of Intelligent Global Hub on Digital Pedagogy (IGHDP) or iHub announced last year. Deliberated upon by senior policy makers and ministers from 9 countries, domain experts in AI, data scientists, neuroscientists, education and developmental psychologists, researchers, curriculum experts, digital instruction designers, game designers, education technology companies, the Declaration calls for establishing standards of digital learning resources to determine digital products best suited to the educational needs of 21st century learners.

This workshop was very beneficial to the students as its related to digital learning resources and education technology companies which are needed for 21st century learners .
